In Lilliput's this term we are going to be focusing on turn taking and sharing. We will be taking part in various group games and activities to promote this such as board games and promoting positive behaviour.

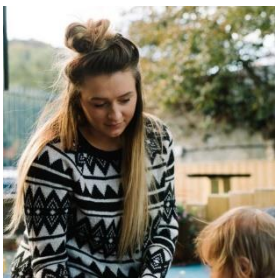
