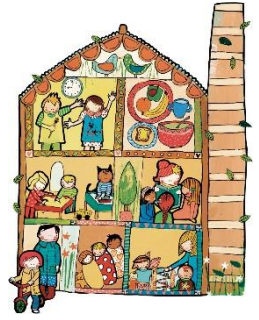


Crossley Mill Nursery

Staff changes

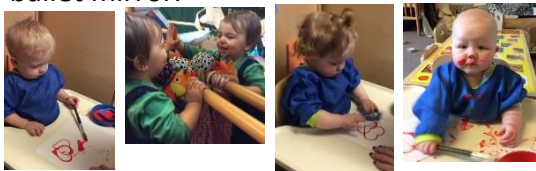

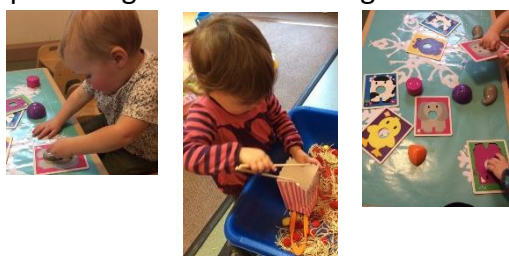
